

# What you need to DO: SIGNAGE (by July 1, 2020)

**“As to buildings and grounds identified herein, signs shall be placed at all entrances giving notice of the prohibition of tobacco use under this Rule. Signs must be posted in other areas of buildings and grounds as reasonably calculated to inform employees and the public of the prohibition.”**

# What Should Signs Look Like?

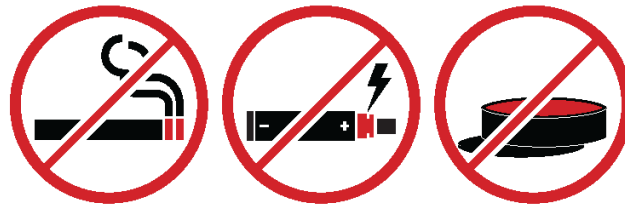
“(c) The signs shall be of **sufficient size** to be clearly legible to a person of normal vision, and be conspicuously posted.

(d) The signs shall state the applicable prohibition (**e.g. Use of Tobacco Products is Prohibited**) and include the **applicable universal symbol** (e.g. the “No Smoking and Use of Tobacco Products Prohibited” symbol).”
